Chairman Lipps, Vice Chair Holmes, Ranking Member Russo, and Members of the House Health Committee, thank you for the opportunity to provide proponent testimony on House Bill 248.

My name is Kurt Feldner and I am an Ohio resident. The reason I support House Bill 248 is because I believe every Ohio resident should have a CHOICE to be vaccinated, based on informed consent and body autonomy.

By allowing employers, organizations, governments, etc, the opportunity to mandate vaccinations, this basically forces the hand of the resident to reveal whether he/she wants to receive or decline the vaccination. This violates my health privacy rights and this is wrong.

I have a daughter who is a labor & delivery nurse in a local hospital who has strong health-related concerns concerning the Covid-19 vaccination, and she does not feel comfortable in receiving the vaccine.
