Chairman Lipps, Vice Chair Holmes, Ranking Member Russo, and Members of the House Health Committee, thank you for the opportunity to provide proponent testimony on House Bill 248.

My name is Stewart Jacob and I am an ordained rabbi and a stay at home dad. The reason I support House Bill 248 is because the right to make one's own personal medical decisions, free of coercion or undue influence, should be sacrosanct and requires the protection of the law. I believe that those who decide not to undergo vaccination will likely become undeserving scapegoats for any future COVID outbreaks, despite the lack of evidence for vaccines stopping transmission. History teaches us that the dehumanization of a disfavored group leads inevitably to disaster. Medical discrimination is not, and can never be, moral.
