





This also effects blood flow especially while under stress &/or anxiety which can cause fainting or passing out (vasovagal syncope/PNES. This may happen more that once per episode, but I am in no danger and simply need rest. Conversion Disorder makes me more likely to be anxious &/or stressed. The mitral valve prolapse is believed to be related to &/or caused by EDS.



Please see the below information that I received from the Ohio Department of Public Safety, and let me know if you have any further questions:

Below are the statewide totals of EMS runs submitted to the Emergency Medical Services Incident Reporting System (EMSIRS), and counts of agencies reporting to that system for each of the years 2019-2021.

Caveats:

- The majority of these runs would be emergency in nature as that is what is required to be reported. Runs such as public assists, lift assists, etc. would not necessarily be reported to the system.
- Incidents where two different agencies may have treated the same patient, only the agency performing the patient transportation to the final destination would have reported the incident to the system to avoid duplicate entries and to insure that accurate final patient disposition data is received.
- While reporting emergent runs is required, the agency reporting compliance rate varies by year with 2020 and 2021 peaking at approximately 85% participation.
- Information for the year 2021 is incomplete and only reflects data received and processed by 9am on 10/25/2021.
