Chair Wiggam, Vice Chair John, Ranking Member Kelly, and the Honored Members of the House, State and Local Government and Reform Committee:

My name is Angie Harkins and thank you for reading my testimony as a proponent on HB90. Please find attached my Witness Information Form.

You are constitutionally obligated to take your power back from Governor Dewine and pass this bill. Please pass HB90 so that We the People may have a say in how we want to address these issues. The people should not be under such dictating rule. People should have the freedom to choose whether they want to wear a mask, whether they want to take a vaccine or other issues related to their health.
