Chairman Wiggam, Vice Chairman John, Ranking Member Kelly, and members of the State and Local Government Reform Committee,

I am testifying today as a proponent of HB 90. My family and I are Ohio residents deeply concerned about courses of action being taken under the current emergency powers.

We are tired of the drastic measures taken in response to the spread of COVID-19, which are enacted in the absence of compelling data to justify them. We are tired of being commanded to wear medical devices on our faces, and verbally assaulted and intimidated when we exercise our right to breathe and interact in the manner humans in society have always done.
