Please provide a brief statement on your position: My name is Abby Hersey and I am a lifelong Ohio resident and voter. I'm a mother to three girls, grandmother to two boys, wife, and business owner. I am submitting testimony today in opposition to House Bill 62, an unconstitutional and confusing bill that puts law enforcement in the impossible position of being sued or suffering job loss for enforcing federal laws or using federal assistance in solving crimes involving firearms. Do you want to see Ohio's law enforcement officers in court having to defend themselves for doing their constitutional duty? Do you want to see them lose their jobs for having done what they are sworn to do? Under the U.S. Constitution's Supremacy Clause, federal laws are the "supreme law of the land" and any state that conflicts with federal law is null and void. HB 62 riles up extremists who believe the federal government is after their gun rights, adding fuel to the fire of dangerous antigovernment sentiment that created destruction and violence, including the loss of life suffered by a law enforcement officer, on January 6th in our nation's capital.

HB62 also sends a confusing message to law-abiding gun owners who may inadvertently expose themselves to criminal liability. After Kansas passed a similar nullification bill, two Kansas men were prosecuted for illegally making and possessing firearm accessories that they wrongly believed were exempt from federal regulation.

Please think about the message you are sending to your constituents if you vote for HB62. This bill is unconstitutional, will cost taxpayers money to defend, is anti-law enforcement and proextremist. I urge you to please vote against House Bill 62.
