These two bills are a cynical, dishonest attempt to muzzle free speech and academic freedom in Ohio public schools. They are part of a national campaign orchestrated by ALEC and other dark money, radical right-wing organizations that seek to restrict honest, open, and accurate discussions about our nation's past.
