To Chairman Wiggam, Vice Chair John, Ranking Member Kelly and members of the House State and Local Government Committee- Below is my testimony for HB 322 &327 combined. My name is Ann Moneypenny and I am testifying in opposition to both of these house bills.

Both bills 322 and 327 are political theater, using Ohio's education system to divide our communities by stroking fire with buzz words that motivate those on the political right. Educators, not politicians should be forming our curriculum. All students regardless of color should learn our history, it's high and low points and discuss how this history still affects our injustices today. Lawmakers introducing these bills are attempting to limit teachers and students from resources on justice and are stroking fear needlessly onto parents.
