I am Dave Bennett, a retired geologist/mining engineer resident of Bolivar, Ohio and House District 98. The Honorable Brett Hillyer is my Representative. I have degrees from Kent State University and Arizona State University. I have been employed in both the copper and coal industries. I also have owned an environmental consulting business. I have been a volunteer District Captain for the Convention of States since March 2021.

I present this testimony:

I've been voting since 1960 with the hope that the country would get better. It hasn't. We've lost more freedom and liberty and it's now happening at an accelerated pace.
