Thank you for hearing sponsor testimony on House Bill 536, legislation that will create a license plate for Chardon High School commemorating their State Championships. This license plate will be available to all applicants for any passenger car, noncommercial vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other approved vehicle.

Therefore, this bill will not only provide recognition for the achievements of this team, but it will also create a lasting legacy that will continue to give back to the community on their behalf.
