

## Jeremy Blake Board Member for Equality Ohio HB 404 - Testimony in SUPPORT of License Plate for Equality Ohio

To Chairman Baldridge, Vice Chair McClain, Ranking Member Sheehy, and members of the Transportation and Public Safety Committee, my name is Jeremy Blake, and I am a proud Board Member of Equality Ohio, our statewide education and advocacy group on behalf of the lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer + (LGBTQ+) community in Ohio.
