There are now 65 county land reutilization corporations, or county land banks, working to strengthen Ohio communities. County land banks are responsible for returning more than 30,000 abandoned, vacant, blighted, and tax-delinquent properties back to productive tax use and leveraging more than \$1 billion in investment.

The Summit County Land Bank has leveraged more than \$75 million in public and private investment, improving thousands of properties, and positively impacting neighborhoods and communities throughout Summit County, thanks to your continued support.

To remain relevant and adapt to the changing needs of Ohio's diverse neighborhoods and communities, Ohio's land bank law must be updated. Ohio's communities depend on the work of county land banks to address issues of abandonment, vacancy, and blight, and to support vital community and economic development efforts.
