Chairman Peterson, Vice Chair Schuring, ranking member Williams, members of the committee, I write as a proponent of SB-52.

I believe this legislation is necessary so that local township residents being affected by proposed wind and solar projects have the ability to vote for or against the building of these projects. I believe that all Ohioans deserve the right to be safe in their homes. The present OPSB process doesn't enforce the safety manual regulations cited in wind turbine manuals during thunderstorms or wind turbine fires, and puts local residents at risk.

No one appreciates being blind-sided.

Those of us who have chosen to live in rural areas should be able to vote on having our rural landscape changed into a heavy industrial zone. Those who live in large cities have chosen to do so understanding the ramifications of big city life. Please consider the rights of those of us who are a part of the rural landscape. SB52 gives us that consideration.
