

**I am strongly opposed to SB 52 for the following reasons:**

**The market for solar and wind is growing and represents an especially needed economic opportunity for rural Ohioans**, including landowners, school districts and political entities. Now is NOT the time to erect barriers! Our local school district here in Champaign County is a case in point.

By artificially restricting energy choices, **this bill will drive up prices for all energy consumers**. (That's ALL of us!) You have yet to rescind HB6. Please stop acting as if our energy costs are your political ballgames!
