I am strongly opposed to SB 52 for the following reasons:

The market for solar and wind is growing and represents an especially needed economic opportunity for rural Ohioans, including landowners, school districts and political entities. Now is NOT the time to erect barriers! Our local school district here in Champaign County is a case in point.

By artificially restricting energy choices, **this bill will drive up prices for all energy consumers.** (That's ALL of us!) You have yet to rescind HB6. Please stop acting as if our energy costs are your political ballgames!

This bill is anti-business: It will dramatically hinder businesses' abilities to exercise energy choice, manage energy costs, and control their future energy costs. WHY do this????

You want business investment in Ohio? I sure hope so! This bill will have the exact opposite effect....How can any responsible business invest in a large-scale project, only to have it subjected to retroactive cancellation at the hands of a very small number of local voters? Our Ohio Power Siting Board already has a strenuous process for overseeing the approval of such projects.

For these and many, many more reasons, I urge you to reject HB 118.
