I am against SB 52 for several reasons:

- -It puts up needless barriers to new markets with the potential to create great prosperity.
- -Restricting the supply of energy when more cost-effective options are available robs both consumers and businesses through unnecessarily high energy bills.
- -It politicizes important infrastructure reform in a way that potentially hinders future, equally critical projects.
- -It retroactively destroys projects that already invested time and money in good faith.
