I am offering this written testimony in support of Amendment SC2521X1 to Substitute House Bill 110, "STEM Entrepreneurship and Innovation Program for Students to Help Develop Ohio's Future Workforce", which continues funding of what is more popularly known as the "Believe in Ohio Student STEM Innovation and Scholarship Program".
