Chairman Roegner, Vice Chairman McColley, Ranking Member Craig, and members of the State and Local Government Committee:

I am testifying today in favor of SB22. I am an Ohio resident and voter deeply concerned about courses of action being taken by the state government under the ongoing emergency powers and the damage it is doing everywhere in the state, especially to the most vulnerable people.

This bill is a step toward restoration of three coequal branches of government.
