Chairman Roegner, Vice Chairman McColley, Ranking Member Craig, and members of the State and Local Government Committee

I am testifying today in favor of SB22 as an Ohio resident <u>DEEPLY</u> concerned about courses of action being taken under the current emergency authority of the Governor.

Currently, there is an imbalance of power with the Executive Branch having *total authority* with all aspects of public health emergencies WITHOUT time constraints.

I understand the need for the Governor to enact a public emergency. However, that authority should be LIMITED until additional information and options are available to include a broad range of legislators.
