My story, I am sure, mimics thousands of other parents in Ohio and the United States. I lost my 25-year-old son to a drug overdose on Nov 12, 2016. With that event, my life and my heart changed forever.

The positive that came from it, is that my husband and I began sharing "Joey's Story" in schools, civic organizations, rehabilitation facilities, medical conferences, churches, just to name a few.

Our purpose was to educate those in attendance on the disease of addiction, and how this disease knows no boundaries, can afflict anyone, and we must do all we can to end the stigma associated with this disease, and those who struggle with it.

We also went on to co-found, Bellevue Recovery and Support Services, which offers assistance to detox, rehab, and/or recovery housing for those struggling with substance use.

We also offer support to their families/loved ones, as they too struggle with what to do.
