. Media headlines are now proclaiming the scarcity of workers. How many potential workers are incarcerated because they cannot pay cash bail when accused of low level, non violent charges. How much is that costing Ohio?: The United States is only one of two nations still imposing cash bail. The other is the Philippines. Help our nation join the rest of the world's 21st century judicial systems.

Support and pass SB182, and without any amendments. Build Ohio's trust in our government and our judicial system.
