I write to encourage you and the other members of the Senate Transportation Committee to restore the language found in the As Introduced version of HB74 that would assist our regional transit system, the Toledo Area Regional Transit Authority (TARTA).

The Chamber supports the development of an efficient, robust, and responsive transit system that promotes the economic well-being of the region. We are supportive of the effort to give TARTA a temporary opportunity to place an issue before the voters in Lucas County and City of Rossford that will allow them to transform their operations and increase accessibility.
