HCR 32 – Sponsor Testimony Senate Veterans and Public Safety Committee 15 November 2022

Chairman Hoagland, Vice Chair Johnson, Ranking Member Thomas, and members of the Senate Veterans and Public Safety Committee. Thank you for the opportunity to testify on behalf of HCR 32. This resolution recommends that the Air Force Research Lab at Wright Patterson Air Force Base recognize Colonel William J. Cavanaugh for his contribution to the design and architecture of the AFRL Bio Acoustics Laboratory. Colonel Cavanaugh was a leader in building a facility at Wright Patterson Air Force Base, which has been used for over six decades.
