Re: Private Label Credit Cards

Dear Chairman Blessing and members of the Senate Ways and Means Committee,

On behalf of Best Buy and our more than 3,250 employees, 32 retail storefronts and 2 distribution centers in the State of Ohio, I am writing to indicate our strong support of House Bill 223.

This legislation expands the bad debt deduction to include transactions made on private label credit cards, for example, a Best Buy credit card that can be used only at a Best Buy store. We believe this expansion provides equity and reflects how retailers offer private label credit cards in today's marketplace. Importantly, it will allow retailers to obtain a refund credit for sales tax when private label card bad debt is written off by the lender.

The retail industry is under great transformation, not only in Ohio but nationwide. While this provision is small considering the overall impact to the state budget, it is significant for our industry.
