To urge the Congress of the United States to propose an	1
amendment to the United States Constitution to	2
establish term limits for members of Congress.	3

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF OHIO (THE SENATE CONCURRING):

WHEREAS, The United States Congress can submit to the	4
states a proposed Constitutional amendment if the proposal is	5
approved by two-thirds majority vote of both the Senate and the	6
House of Representatives; and	7
WHEREAS, There are currently no term limits for the office	8
of member of the United States Senate or the office of member of	9
the United States House of Representatives; now therefore be it	10
RESOLVED, That we, the members of the 134th General	11
Assembly of the State of Ohio, urge the Congress of the United	12
States to propose an amendment to the United States Constitution	13
to establish term limits for the office of member of the United	14
States Senate and the office of member of the United States	15
House of Representatives as described in this resolution; and be	16

United States Constitution to establish term limits prohibiting a person from holding the office of member of the United States Senate for a period longer than three successive terms of six years, which shall not include any term served for purpose of filling a vacancy in the Senate; and be it further

RESOLVED, That Congress should propose an amendment to the United States Constitution to establish term limits prohibiting a person from holding the office of member of the United States House of Representatives for a period longer than nine successive terms of two years, which shall not include any term served for the purpose of filling a vacancy in the United States House of Representatives; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the proposed amendment should specify that terms shall be considered successive unless separated by a period of two or more years. Only terms beginning after the amendment takes effect shall be considered in determining an individual's eligibility to hold office; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the Ohio House of 36 Representatives shall transmit duly authenticated copies of this 37 resolution to the President Pro Tempore of the United States 38 Senate, the Speaker of the United States House of 39 Representatives, each member of the Ohio Congressional 40 delegation, each Senate President and Speaker of the House of 41 Representatives, or equivalent, for every state, and the news 42 media of Ohio. 43
