Unsubscribed electricity 84

R.C. 4934.07 85

Adds to the bill provisions for "unsubscribed electricity" 86
to specify that (1) an electric distribution utility (EDU) with 87
a community solar facility in its certified territory must 88
allocate bill credits for all electricity generated by the 89
facility and attributable to a subscription under the bill, (2) 90
a community solar organization (CSO) may account for 91
unsubscribed electricity on a monthly basis and accumulate bill 92
credits for the unsubscribed electricity for up to 12 months 93
after it was generated, and (3) bill credits for unsubscribed 94

electricity must be allocated to future subscribers at the	95
direction of the CSO.	96
Requires a CSO to furnish to the EDU an allocation for	97
distribution of bill credits to subscribers for unsubscribed	98
electricity.	99
Requires a CSO to forfeit to the EDU any bill credits for	100
unsubscribed electricity that are not allocated as described	101
above.	102
Removes the provisions requiring that an EDU with a	103
community solar facility in its certified territory must (1)	104
purchase all electricity generated by the facility that is	105
attributable to a subscriber's bill credit and (2) purchase the	106
unsubscribed electricity from the facility at the utility's	107
wholesale energy cost as approved by the Public Utilities	108
Commission.	109
Subscription share of less than 100% of electric usage	110

Removes from the bill, the provisions describing that a	112
