Registry of foreign adversaries	16
R.C. 5301.256 (H)	17
Specifies that the Secretary of State (SOS) may not	18
include any person on the list of foreign adversaries subject to	19
the bill's real property restrictions, other than a country that	20
appears on at least one of the following:	21
--The list of governments determined to be foreign	22
adversaries by the U.S. Secretary of Commerce;	23
--The terrorist exclusion list compiled by the U.S.	24
Secretary of State;	25
--The state sponsors of terrorism designated by the U.S.	26
Secretary of State;	27
--The list of persons designated by Executive Orders 13224	28
and 13268.	29
Under current law and the current version of the bill, the	30
SOS is required to "consult" those federal lists in compiling	31
the registry, but is not expressly limited by them.	32
Under current law, the SOS may include any "person" -	33
which includes individuals, businesses, organizations, legal or	34
commercial entities, and governments - on the registry, but only	35
the persons listed are subject to the real property	36
restrictions. Under both the bill and the amendment, the SOS may	37
only list countries - called "foreign adversaries" - on the	38
registry, but the restrictions apply to that country's citizens	39

and certain associated businesses.
