(C) Not later than the first day of July immediately 215

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following the effective date of this section, the Chancellor216shall issue a report that includes the model policy, guidance,217best practices, and recommendations for further action developed218by the committee. The Chancellor shall submit the report to the219Governor, the President and Minority Leader of the Senate, and220the Speaker and Minority Leader of the House of Representatives.221

Section 3. All items in this act are hereby appropriated 222 as designated out of any moneys in the state treasury to the 223 credit of the designated fund. For all operating appropriations 224 made in this act, those in the first column are for fiscal year 225 2024 and those in the second column are for fiscal year 2025. 226 The operating appropriations made in this act are in addition to 227 any other operating appropriations made for these fiscal years. 228
