#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF OHIO:

<b>Section 1.</b> That section 3301.0722 of the Revised Code be	6
enacted to read as follows:	7
Sec. 3301.0722. (A) There is hereby created the Ohio	8
social studies standards task force. The task force shall	9
consist of nine members, three each appointed by the governor,	10
president of the senate, and speaker of the house of	11
representatives.	
(B) Subject to division (E) of this section, the task	13
force shall develop statewide academic standards in social	
studies for grades kindergarten through twelve based on the	15
standards published in "American Birthright: The Civics	16
Alliance's Model K-12 Social Studies Standards," a product of	17
the national association of scholars or its successor	1.8

organization.		
(C) The task force shall provide opportunities for public	20	
input when developing the standards, including the input of both	21	
of the following:		
(1) Parents of students in kindergarten through twelfth	23	
<pre>grade;</pre>	24	
(2) Active Ohio classroom teachers, other school	25	
personnel, and administrators with expertise in the social	26	
studies subject area.		
(D) (1) The task force shall report its statewide social	28	
studies academic standards to the primary and secondary	29	
education committees of both the house of representatives and		
the senate not later than August 15, 2023.	31	
(2) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in section	32	
3301.079 of the Revised Code, the standards submitted under	33	
division (D)(1) of this section shall not be effective unless	34	
approved by the general assembly by concurrent resolution. Once		
so approved, the standards shall be in force for a period of	36	
five school years beginning with the 2024-2025 school year.	37	
If the primary and secondary education committees of both	38	
the house of representatives and senate fail to report the	39	
standards as submitted for consideration by the general	40	
assembly, or the general assembly fails to approve the standards	41	
as submitted by concurrent resolution within two months of the	42	
date of the initial report under division (D)(1) of this	43	
section, the task force shall reconvene and report revised		
standards to the primary and secondary education committees.	45	
(E) The department shall revise the model curriculum for	46	
social studies under section 3301.079 of the Revised Code to	47	

reflect the standards adopted under this section. These		
standards shall not conflict with the requirement to incorporate	49	
into the social studies standards the original texts of	50	
documents of the United States and the state of Ohio prescribed	51	
by division (A)(1)(b) of section 3301.079 of the Revised Code.	52	
(F) The department shall notify and make available to all	53	
school districts, community schools, STEM schools, and nonpublic	54	
schools that are required to administer the American history and		
American government end-of-course examinations prescribed by		
section 3301.0712 of the Revised Code of the standards developed		
and adopted under this section.		
(G) The task force created under division (A) of this	59	
section ceases to exist once the social studies standards	60	
developed by that task force take effect under division (D)(2)	61	
of this section.	62
