My name is Sarah Kramer and I live on Ortego Dr in Rona Hills just down wind and a couple miles at most from the Renergy Biodigester located on Herr Road in Bath Township. The Air Force brought us here in 1985 and my husband medically retired here in 1987. Our home is paid off and we intended to stay here and right now no one would want to purchase a home here.

I **USED** to hang my clothes on the clothes line to dry, open my windows to let the house air out, eat outside, take walks through the neighborhood early in the morning with my dogs, sit on my front porch glider in the morning watching the morning watching the sun rise. This has all **STOPPED** since Renergy Biodigester has made Rona Hills smell like we are living in raw sewage 24/7!

I have asthma that now awakens me coughing in the middle of the night from the stench permeating through our CLOSED Pella windows and insulated brick walls. We are running the air conditioner when it is below 75 degrees so I can breathe. HOWEVER that still doesn't cover the smell!

I have developed severe migraines and what they now are calling silent migraines which are another form of migraines. My list of medications has grown since this sewage pit came into existence and has taken over my neighborhood and our entire town.

How can the town of Fairborn, home of Wright Patterson Air Force Base expect to welcome people here and expect people to buy homes and go to school, enjoy the parks, and the back yards when it even violates the boundaries of the brick and mortise of their homes?

My husband was born and raised on a dairy beef farm in NE Iowa. I am from a suburb of NE Philadelphia and lived on the farm for a few years before the AF. I milked the cows and cleaned out the cow manure and it never smelled this bad. There just is no comparison.

Please clean up my community's air.
