

## House Families and Aging Committee Chair Schmidt HB 465

We appreciate the opportunity to present interested party testimony to the House Families and Aging Committee. The Ohio Provider Resource Association represents over 180 providers of long-term services for Ohioans with developmental disabilities (DD) from across the state. The OPRA membership provides services to Ohioans and their families in a broad array of settings, including in intermediate care facilities (ICF). OPRA appreciates the opportunity to provide comment on HB 465.

The families who provided testimony April 17<sup>th</sup>, 2024, opened an important dialogue with the General Assembly on how the DD service system can continue to offer high quality services and further prevent abuse.
