**I** am unable to attend the hearing on April 26, 2023 but wish to submit this written statement. I am a proponent of changing the margin from 50% + 1 vote to a minimum of 60% requirement to Amend Ohio's Constitution. Amending the State's founding document is such a serious matter that it should require a greater margin for victory for either side <u>so that there is no doubt about</u> <u>the will of the majority Ohioans as to their support of the measure</u>. Although special elections are costly, it is worth the cost in this case. A ballot initiative is expected to be on the November ballot for all Ohioans, and <u>it is important to place this matter of the majority vote needed to Amend</u> <u>the Constitution of Ohio before all Ohioans in a special election in August so that the November</u> <u>vote will give a more clear indication of what the majority of Ohioans believe is best for their</u> <u>state to amend the constitution, not just by 50% of the vote plus 1 vote. Amending our Ohio</u> <u>Constitution is so important; common sense tells me that a 50% + 1 vote margin is woefully</u> <u>inadequate, especially if there is any error in counting ballots</u>.
