refused by the pharmacy and eventually that doctor was kicked out of that practice for not

promoting the shots and trying to help people get better with other tried and true

treatments.

In closing, I would like to reiterate that Ohioans should have their right of conscience and

religion protected from the medical over-reach of employers or those providing public services.

Both the U.S. and Ohio State constitutions address the right of conscious and religious freedom.

It is time to make sure that those freedoms are protected at the state level.

I urge the committee members to please vote yes on HB 319.
