Thank you for taking the time to read my testimony. I'm trans and nonbinary. Most people assume I'm a man from the way I look, but I have an "F" on my birth certificate. The bill you are considering would force me to use the Women's bathroom at Tri-C, where I take French.

Even before medically transitioning, people would assume I was a man based on the way I looked. Back in those days I used to generally use the women's restroom. I've had women scream upon seeing me in the women's room. I very frequently have been told, "You're in the wrong one." I've twice been followed into a restroom by armed security. This is frightening for me.

I'm a human being, a parent of two small kids, and a person of faith. Forcing me to use the women's restroom is harmful to me and doesn't benefit anyone.

Please do not pass this bill.
