I am a retired chemist and medical administrative worker who served more than twenty five years as a Sunday School teacher, twenty two of those years in Ohio. My husband is a physician.

I strongly object to the provisions of HB 11 and I urge you to halt it now in committee. HB 11 would force me, as an Ohio citizen, to fund private education with my taxpayer dollars, more than currently. It also will deprive public education of much needed funds. With HB 11 taxpayer funds will be provided to private education without much needed oversight and regulation. Private schools in Ohio already can discriminate about which students they admit and under HB 11, discrimination can occur funded by my taxpayer dollars!
