Testimony in favor of HB 339

Chairman Bird, Vice Chair Fowler Arthur, Ranking Member Robinson and distinguished members of the House Primary and Secondary Education Committee, thank you for the opportunity to advocate for House Bill 339.

I am the administrator of Temple Christian Academy, a non-charter, nonpublic school. I have served in this position for the past 13 years. It has been my joy to see the students of our school learn and overcome the challenges they face in learning. But each year I watch as many of the parents of our students struggle to make the financial sacrifice to pay the tuition for their student's education. The expansion of school choice last year through the EdChoice voucher program brought a new set of problems for some of our families. They were notified a few months ago that the scholarship would be closing due to the EdChoice expansion and the lack of need for it.
