Our child has gone from a suicidal, self harming kid who didn't see a way to live in this world, to a 21 year old moving out into his first apartment with his long term (5 years!) partner, looking at jobs/careers/colleges to support their independent lives together.

He is kind, loving, creative, and brilliant, on the cusp of contributing to the world. The world almost lost out on all the things he'll do in his future, and I can't even bear to imagine how gray our world would be without him. He still struggles with depression and anxiety, because it runs in the family on both sides and because religious conservative bullies can't see the beauty in the diversity of all of our children. Our family has grown to be more flexible, adaptable, and stronger because of our differences. We use our differences as strengths, and lean on each other's strength's to make our way through life.

Please look to the WPATH research and guidelines as you think about this issue. Don't just listen to what other people tell you is the truth; go look at the medical research done by reputable organizations for yourself. There are many misrepresented studies, skewed statistics, and outright lies that have been told, trying to support this bill that would take away parental rights and take away healthcare access for children.
