I strongly opposed the HB 68 bill and urge that you vote NO. I trust parents to make the right decisions for their children and I trust doctors to make the best evidence based decisions for their patients. This bill grossly infringes on parents' rights to provide care to their children and on medical experts rights to provide the best possible treatment for their patients that will serve them in both the short and long term future. This bill is the latest example of government politicians selectively choosing their biases over data driven facts and practices. It continues to serve the politicians and the power that they hold instead of serving the safety and well-being of the citizens of the state of Ohio. Gender Affirming Care is evidence based practice and this bill would limit doctors, psychologists, social workers, and many other professionals from performing their jobs the best way they can. This bill also would negatively impact an already at risk population for suicide attempts and suicide ideation. Transgender children are eight times as likely to be suicidal and this bill would create more barriers for this population to receive the mental and physical care they need.
