

HB 33 Interested Party Testimony

Thank you for allowing me to testify today. My name is Kimberly King and I am the Chief Operating Officer at Home Care Network. We provide HCBS services across Ohio for State Plan, Aging, MyCare and Developmental Disabilities, and am before you today to discuss more specifics on our rate increase requests to provide greater access to care and technology.

As this Subcommittee is well aware, the healthcare workforce is seeing strains like never before. With the pandemic winding down, a short supply of clinicians are receiving high hourly wages. In contrast, HCBS providers lose money on nearly every hour of Medicaid services that we provide as reimbursement rates have remained virtually unchanged over the past 20 years. This is simply unsustainable. In order to continue providing HCBS services our agencies require wages competitive with the marketplace. If we are to keep Ohioans home rather than in an institution, HCBS needs equity in reimbursement so we can hire staff with competitive wages.



Today, home-care providers schedule time in the home with Ohioans based on when they can fit into a caregiver's schedule. Staff extenders will become a critical element in proactively identifying when a patient is likely to need care, as opposed to providing care only when a visit can be scheduled. In order to resolve this access to care issue in Ohio we must enable a provider to pay a competitive wage for staff, as well as utilizing technology to extend the reach of a caregiver.
