HB 75 – Sponsor Testimony Ohio House Transportation Committee March 21, 2023

Thank you for your testimony, Representative Lampton. Caitlin was a member of the choir at Kenton Ridge High School, from which she graduated a few weeks before her death. Additionally, her

athletic accomplishments earned her scholarships and a spot on the bowling team at Tiffin University, where she planned to study Forensic Science. Caitlin left a tremendous legacy during her time on this side of heaven, and it is our duty to keep her memory alive for many years to come. This highway is more than just a stretch of road – it is an enduring reminder of Caitlin's brief but impactful life in western Ohio.
