After finding the correct department, that department would reach out to the owner of the pet. The public entity will keep and maintain a sanitary place to store deceased dogs and cats, respectfully. Allowing pet owners up to 24 hours to retrieve their beloved dog or cat.

This is a bill that just makes sense. It allows the families to have a sense of closure which in times of a pets disappearance is the best gift anyone could give.
