Previous Version (As Introduced)	Latest Version (I_135_1360-2)
Eligibility requirements	
 Authorizes a property tax reduction for homeowners or homes that meet the following requirements: Be at least 70 years old; Continuously have lived in the homestead for at least 10 years; Have a total annual income of \$70,000 or less; The appraised value of the home must be less than \$1 million (<i>R.C. 323.152 and 4503.0612</i>). 	 Modifies each requirement as follows: Lowers the age to qualify to at least 65 years old; Reduces the continual occupancy requirement to two years; Reduces the total annual income to qualify to \$50,000 or less; Reduces the home value necessary to qualify to less than \$500,000 (<i>R.C. 323.152 and 4503.0612</i>).
