Honorable Chairman Roemer, Vice Chair Lorenz, and Ranking Member Troy,

My name is Geoff Hoffman. I am a landlord owner managing a duplex on the west side of Cleveland, and I have successfully completed both the initial and renewal lead safe testing required by the city. My tenants, who are working-class families, rely on landlords like myself to provide safe, high-quality housing in areas where such options are scarce.

Today, I wish to express my support for House Bill 280 due to several key provisions that will benefit both tenants and landlords:

1. Streamlined Regulations: The bill proposes uniform state-wide regulations, including a mandated 30-day response period for cities on lead safety applications and a 180-day window for landlords to correct deficiencies. This will significantly reduce the bureaucratic hurdles that currently hinder prompt compliance.

2. Tax Credit Reform: Converting the underutilized non-refundable tax credit into a fully refundable one is critical. This adjustment will extend benefits to pass-through entities, greatly assisting landlords who invest in necessary safety upgrades such as window replacements and testing. Currently, there is a significant gap between the \$5 million allocated by the legislature for these purposes and the mere \$50,000 that has been utilized. This reform is essential to make these funds accessible and effective.

3. Support for Property Owners and Community Standards: As a realtor representing both sellers and buyers of these properties, I see firsthand how these funds could facilitate compliance with Cleveland's new residents' first standards and promote equitable outcomes for all parties involved.

I urge the committee to consider these proposals collaboratively with landlords who are committed to ensuring secure and high-quality housing for Ohio's lower and middle-income families. Our collective goal is to provide safe and comfortable living conditions for all Ohioans, especially our children.
