 schools didn't deal with it very well. Before I came to this school,
 my educational environment was not the best. Now that I'm at
 Heritage, I can focus more on my education. I figured out that I
 want to be a chemist, and to do that, I have to get good grades
 to go to college. The scholarship program in Ohio has allowed
 me to find the school that will help me to meet my goals.
- Also, I'm glad that I have the **choice** to go to a school that teaches me about God.
- Having a scholarship brought me to a school that allowed me to learn in the way that fits **me**. I'm happy to answer any of your questions.
