Good Afternoon,

Thank you for providing the public the opportunity to testify on SB #137. I wish to express my sincere opposition to this bill for several reasons.

- 1) Voters from all demographics and political blocs not only use Ranked Choice Voting (RCV) effectively, but also the vast majority of those who have used it like it and find it simple. Arguing that Ohioans are somehow less capable of "ranking" than Alaskans, New Yorkers, or Virginians is an insult to our state's residents.
- 2) The bill is a violation of home rule, plain and simple.
