- Ohio ranks 9<sup>th</sup> nationally in business entities licensed.
- Ohio ranks 16<sup>th</sup> in the world in direct premium written.

While Ohio is a member of the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC), it's important to note that the NAIC itself is a consortium of state insurance regulators. This organization plays a crucial role in the state-based insurance regulatory system by fostering collaboration and developing standards and best practices. These efforts ensure a more consistent approach to insurance regulatory framework including language protecting the department's NAIC accreditation rules.
