## DETAILED ANALYSIS

| License Plate | Purdue University license plate, which must display an appropriate logo and <br> words, selected by representatives of Purdue University and approved by the <br> Registrar of Motor Vehicles. ${ }^{1}$ |
| :--- | :--- |
| Recipients | Available to all applicants. |
| Eligible Vehicles | Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or <br> other vehicle approved by the Registrar. |
| Contribution; <br> Additional BMV Fee; <br> Use of Contribution | \$30 required contribution. <br> \$10 additional administrative BMV fee. <br> Contributions must be paid to Purdue University located in West Lafayette, <br> Indiana, for awarding grants or scholarships to Ohio residents who attend the <br> University. The University may not use any of the funds it receives for <br> administering the scholarship program. ${ }^{2}$ |
| Requirements for <br> Issuance | 1. Submission of an application; <br> 2. Payment of the regular license tax, any local tax, contribution, <br> administrative fee, any special reserved license plate fee if necessary; and <br> 3. Compliance with all other relevant laws relating to motor vehicle registration. |
| Combined with Special <br> Reserved License Plate | May be combined with a special reserved license plate provided in current <br> law. |
