The bill has no direct fiscal effect on the state or political subdivisions. It exempts certain noncommercial seed sharing activities from the laws governing seed labeling, permitting, inspection, advertising, and sales reporting. Additionally, it aligns the list of weeds that must be removed from a toll road, railroad, or electric railway to the list of noxious weeds that must be removed from other roads and road right-of-ways. More details concerning the changes to law that affect seed sharing activities, as well as changes that align the definition of noxious weeds in statute, can be found in the LSC bill analysis.
