## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Lance Corporal Gerald Subler Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
Highway	Northbound and southbound lanes of State Route 185 between Burns Road and Progress Way in Darke County.
Other Information	Lance Corporal Gerald Subler served in the United States Marine Corps during the Vietnam War. He was killed by communist forces on September 30, 1968, as a result of multiple shrapnel wounds from hostile rocket fire.
