The bill requires (1) each county veterans' service commission to include at least two members who served in the military after September 11, 2001, and (2) one member of each county veterans' service commission to be appointed by the board of county commissioners. Consequently, under the bill, each county board of commissioners may incur some slight additional cost to appoint a member of their veterans' service commission. Current law requires all five members to be appointed by a judge of the court of common pleas from lists of recommended persons. The bill transfers appointment authority, for one of the five positions on each veterans' service commission, from the judge of the court of commons pleas to the board of commissioners of the county. The board of county commissioners appoints a member from the lists provided by the Military Order of the Purple Heart of the U.S.A., the Vietnam Veterans of America, or the Korean War Veterans Association.
